GEORGE'S VISION FOR CRIMINAL HISTICE REFORM FOR L.A. COUNTY

Establish a criminal justice system based on accountability by implementing stricter standards for when police can use force and enacting innovative reform measures that combat racial injustice, eliminate the use of the death penalty, and stop officer-involved killings.

Strengthen public safety and expand victims' rights by making it easier for victims to report consumer fraud, physical abuse, or hate crimes, and partner with community organizations to bring a trauma-informed approach to serving victims in high-crime and violent neighborhoods.

Use solutions to save money and allow for more investment in mental health and drug treatment, and reduce the costs to taxpayers of over-incarceration by providing more opportunities for rehabilitation like education and job training so people can become productive members of our community.

GEORGE'S RECORD OF FIGHTING FOR A FAIRER SYSTEM

- George stood up for women and cracked down on crimes like rape and sexual assault. As San Francisco District Attorney, he prosecuted more than double the national average of sexual assault cases and successfully fought to test every rape kit.
